## Cancer is a Fungus Which Bicarb Soda Kills

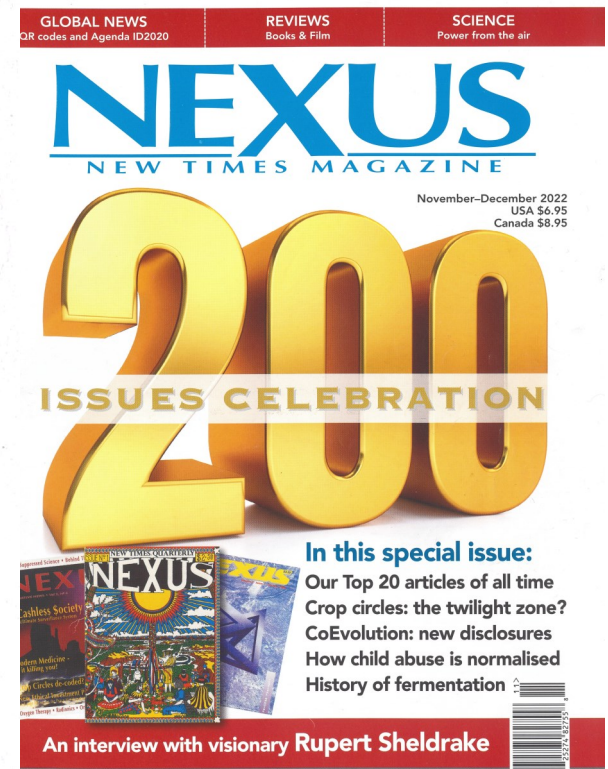
